Fr. William Writes

Blessings of grace, life, and happiness to all Mothers today. We honor the Mother of all, Our Blessed Lady, by the **May Crowning**. The 25th Session of the Council of Trent on the 4th December 1563 presided over by Pope Pius IV speaking of Sacred Images taught: "Images are venerated 'not because of a belief that these images themselves possess anything of divinity or power, but because the honor shown them is directed to the prototypes they represent'". Our thanks to the Catechists and the children for their love of Our Lord's Mother, a love which warms all our hearts.

The Buddeke House Sign, recommended by the Parish Pastoral Council a couple of years back, was made and finally installed last Friday 10th May. Our thanks to Mr. Tim Templeton for the design of the sign, and of course, for his regular assistance as an Extraordinary Minister of Holy Communion at the 11am Sunday Mass.
