Fr. William Writes

Safety and Security: there is a concern in every Parish about security, with assaults on clergy and on people, even some fatalities. We had a potentially dangerous incident here which resulted in TV coverage and a court case against the man who shoved parishioners and abused and resisted legitimate Police intervention. There is an announcement below about Safety and Security. If you are willing to serve the Parish in this capacity please read the item below and respond to it.

Parking: Please park in the designated places; it is selfish not to observe the markings in the parking lot and worse when people ignore and disobey the instructions of those men authorized to direct parking.

Priest Changes: are happening Diocesan-wide in the near future. I will not be in the Parish after June 10th; I am not yet able to tell you who will take my place. At the time of writing (Friday 17th May, 2.00 pm) I have not yet heard from the Abbot of St. Michael's Abbey in Orange County, CA, about my next appointment.
