My heart is filled with gratitude at knowing all of you. I have Baptized 61 people, Confirmed 30 people, given First Holy Communion to many as well, as well as Officiating at a number of Marriages. There are so many good people here, seeking to do what is right, and staying close to their Catholic Faith. Thank you for the courtesy, kindness, and understanding you have shown me. **I am so glad that Fr. Bede Price is your new priest;** I prayed that he would be the one chosen by Bishop Spalding to come here, and I am overjoyed that Fr. Price will be Pastor of the Church of the Assumption. Fr. Price comes with strong pastoral experience in chaplaincy, parish work, and education. As the Byzantine Church sings: "God grant him many years". I offer 9.00am Mass on Monday 10th in the Extraordinary Form, my last Mass here. I fly out to California later in the day hence the earlier than usual start for Monday's Mass.
