Liturgical Note:

Today's joyful feast is one of the oldest in the church calendar. It was being celebrated in Jerusalem in the 4th century and in Rome since the 7th.

The name "Candlemas" is popularly given to the Feast because of the custom of carrying candles in procession on this day.

This procession will occur before the 8:30 Mass. Candles will be blessed and then distributed at the Communion rail. The custom is to kiss the candle as it is given to you by the priest. Afterwards the priest and servers will process through the church in commemoration of our Savior coming into the temple 40 days after his birth. The Faithful should stand with their candles in the pews as we celebrate Christ coming into our midst. Afterwards the candles should be extinguished.
