Construction update: so far the following items have been removed from the church; stained glass windows (to be re-leaded, repaired or rebuilt), pews (FBH Chapel and the Catholic Pastoral Center, climate controlled), the organ & Pipes have been moved by Milnar Organ to Eagleville, TN also in climate controlled storage. The carpet has been removed as well as all furnishings that could be removed. 4 statues and 2 pedestals have been removed and stored as well. Scaffolding has started going up and will be completed once the altars and murals have been removed. The altar removal should begin next week, all 3 of them. They will be restored before they are returned. The murals can be removed and taken for restoration once the altars have been removed. Once all of the above has been completed, only then can the engineers get up to the ceiling and fully assess the damage to the plaster and lath beneath. We are hoping once that has been assessed we will have an estimated time frame for the project.
