Construction update: The engineers assessed the damage to the ceiling plaster and lath. Report expected by the end of July. The High Altar and Side Altars have been removed and are being restored in Wisconsin. The Bas-Relief of the Assumption, which was thought to have been plaster is actually carved of solid wood and MUCH heavier than expected! With the assistance of a couple of cranes and the closure of roads, the steeple was removed Friday and sent for repair. Work should begin soon on removing OSB board from the windows in Buddeke House, Fr. Bernard Hall, the duplex and the Rectory and replacing the broken panes of glass. Work on replacing all copper roofs should begin soon. The murals should be removed sometime in June or July and taken to be restored.
