Finance: There will be a FY bulletin insert for the parish as to the finances coming forth in November after the vocations push requested by the Bishop is over. Mr. Joe Murphy has resigned as financial representative. Names were asked to be submitted for Fr. to approach. Suggestion was made to ask Joe to suggest a substitute.

Religious Ed. Ms. Simpson was absent but sent in a written report. 2 ladies have begun Catechesis of the Good Shepherd, on-line inquiries are being followed up for RCIA. Confirmation Class will be having their retreat at Break at the Lake in Nov. held on JPPI's campus. Confirmation is April 17th at 7:00 at the Cathedral of the Incarnation.

Women's Group. Ms. Miller was absent but sent in a written report. The women's group donated a check for \$ 2000.00 to go towards the new floor in the schoolhouse kitchen floor and \$100.00 gift to St. Pius' Women's group for charitable work.

Buildings and Grounds: Mr. Goodrum stated that the outside of the Buddeke house work is completed and ready for landscaping. Work on the inside to abate the water damage will begin soon. A schematic of the landscaping was presented from LSI for the new landscaping of the Buddeke House. Fr. was asked to check on handrails for the Buddeke House and with the Historical Society on placement of an elevator for the Buddeke House.
