

Church of Assumption Parish Council, May 21, 2015

Minutes were accepted

Finances are good and were approved. It was requested to hold a finance committee meeting to begin the operation of that function again. The meeting will be held before the next council meeting to set spending/budget for the community.

Liturgy: Fr. reported that Fr. McGowan is in residence and the E.F. Mass will begin the 2<sup>nd</sup> week of August. Masses will be 8:30 and 11:00. It was suggested to have an article in the register, advertise the changes via church communication.

The Bishop wanted the Stained glass covered on the front of the building. Price \$14,000.00-- diocese paid ½ (approx. \$7000.00)

Bell repair is on calendar, all 3 bells will be attached not just the 1 we expected.

Rectory we be open to adult/young adult activities at specific times after the beginning of the next education year. (no children activities)

Women's Group: was not represented; tabled.

Building and Grounds: Germantown Abbey work has been approved by Historic Committee and Bishop. Work may proceed.

Care of buildings was discussed. New thermostats are to be placed in the sanctuary, school building and Abbey that are programmable. Ms. Rost will check into this.

Bulletin notices should be made to lift up and make aware of the need for the care of our campus.

Lighting of interior of the sanctuary is on track to be installed

Electrical panel in sacristy is repaired and switches are now notated.

Old Business: LifeTeen is pulling out. LifeTeen left their funds to the church since the monies were not going to be used as originally allotted. This money will be used to replace the carpeting in the duplexes with laminate flooring. Bishop discussed rental pricing for Assumption housing to regulate pricing "across the board" for the diocese. The kitchen in the rectory was noted that it needed to be redone. Suggestions were given for contacts.

New Business: It was suggested to have separate bulletins for St. Pius X and Assumption. This will be done.
