

A few minutes a day to greater happiness
Resentment or anger takes up space in our hearts that is meant for love and happiness. And it hurts us more than the ones for whom it is intended. One sure way to be happier right now is to spend a few minutes offering forgiveness to anyone who has hurt you.

Make a list of those who have hurt you and whom you still resent.

Acknowledge the hurt you feel toward each person. Try writing a letter describing your feelings. Don't send the letter but put it in a drawer, burn it, shred it, or lock it away.

Picture the face of each person and instead of anger, try to conjure feelings of understanding and warmth. Say, "I forgive you," as you picture him or her. Repeat this exercise every day until the feelings become genuine.

Retrain your brain. When you see or think of your former "enemies," ask God to rain down blessings on him or her. It's hard to hate someone you bless.
