## From the Desk of Fr. John

### *“Proclaiming the Word”*

Re-introduced to the Church with Vatican II was the participation of the laity in the Liturgy as Proclaimers of the Word. Since then, many people throughout our parishes have accepted the invitation to read the word at daily and Sunday Masses.

Of course, throughout the Church’s history, the proclamation of faith and the great message of Jesus’ Resurrection has been central to the spreading of faith all over the world. St. Paul, among others, proclaimed the Word to encourage, correct and invite people to a deeper faith with God in Christ.

During the month of February I will be turning my attention more intently on the Proclaimers of the Word for our parish through a series of **Lector Workshops**. The Workshops will be held in the Church on Monday evenings at 7:30pm, on February 13<sup>th</sup>, 20<sup>th</sup> and 27<sup>th</sup>. Currently, I am inviting various parishioners to consider this important and beautiful ministry for themselves. I am also inviting current Lectors to be with us as well.

As Jesus invited His Apostles to go out and tell the “good news” so we must continue to Proclaim His Word with faith and conviction.

The Cardinal’s Office has informed us that **The Annual Cardinal’s Appeal 2017** pledge cards are being mailed during these two weeks. 
