**SAINT IGNATIUS LOYOLA**

**FEAST DAY: JULY 31<sup>st</sup>**

Ignatius Loyola founded the Jesuits (the Society of Jesus). The Jesuits were one of the major spearheads of the Counter-Reformation. The work done by Ignatius Loyola was seen as an important counter to Martin Luther and John Calvin.



He was born in 1491 into a wealthy noble family. He was educated as a knight and then joined the army. In May 1521, he was wounded at the Battle of Pamplona while fighting against France. While Loyola recovered from his wounds he underwent a spiritual conversion. He devoted hours each day to prayer and tending to the sick and poor.

In 1523, Loyola travelled to the Holy Land in an attempt to convert the Moors. However, he was sent back by the Franciscans to Italy. Loyola spent the next seven years furthering his education. During his time of studying Loyola collected eight followers who shared his beliefs. In 1534, they swore obedience to the Pope and also took vows of poverty and chastity. Loyola and his followers determined to dedicate their lives as missionaries to the Holy Land.

In 1540, the Society for Jesus received formal recognition from Pope Paul III. Loyola had been ordained as a priest in 1537 and he spent much time in Rome where he organised the work of the Jesuits as the order's first General. Loyola had become convinced that he could not do his work within an existing order, hence his determination to start his own. Education and self-examination were at the heart of the movement and after years of training, a Jesuit was considered fully prepared to carry out his work in the world.

When Loyola died on July 31, 1556, there were an estimated 1,000 Jesuits organised into eleven units. Nine units were in Europe, one in Brazil and one in the Far East.

The Jesuits transformed the Roman Catholic Church in terms of quality and they became a vital part of the Counter-Reformation. Ignatius Loyola was canonised in 1622.
