The celebration of Mardi Gras came to North America from Paris, where it had been celebrated since the Middle Ages. The first celebration in the US was in 1699 when explorer —Jean Baptiste Le Moyne Sieur de Bienville— landed near what is now known as New Orleans.

Mardi Gras (French for "Fat Tuesday") reflects the practice of the last night of eating rich foods before the ritual fasting of the Lenten season, which marks the beginning of Lent — a forty-day period of fast and abstinence to honor the journey of Christ into the desert.

While many of us here in the US may associate it with New Orleans, it is a Catholic holiday rich in history and tradition that spans the globe.
