Over the years, our parish has relied on fundraising to pay for various projects around the Church. Some are big and some are small. Approximately 50 years ago, some smart parishioners came up with this "Two Grand Club" idea to raise money. There are many parishioners who have had their number since the very beginning, and many have more than one number. It is a fun way to win some money.
