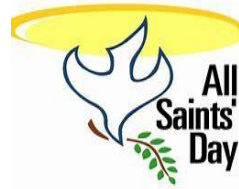

For your safety, please sit in designated areas only.

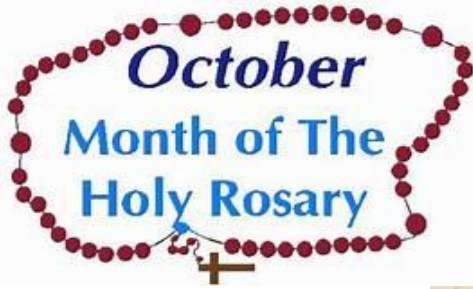
BLUE - Single person / GREEN - More than 3 people
