This year we mark the 20th anniversary of the terrorist's attack on September 11, 2001. Terrorists crashed passenger planes into the World Trade Center's Twin Towers in New York, into the Pentagon – the US Department of Defense headquarters in Arlington County, Virginia and into a field in Somerset County, Pennsylvania, 130 miles northwest of Washington, DC, the intended destination. Over 3,000 people were killed: 2753 in New York City, 184 at the Pentagon, and 40 on Flight 93 in Pennsylvania and many have died

We remember and pray for those who lost their lives, those who grew up without a parent, those who lost a child, a sibling, a spouse, a friend, those who were present that day, the first responders who worked so hard and were sickened by the dangerous, toxic environment.
