Please come together with Father Chris, Reverend Erin Moore, the fire department, emergency responders, various groups, organizations & parishioners from Saint Columba and the Chester Community as they gather to REMEMBER.

This year we mark the 20th anniversary of the terrorist's attack on September 11, 2001. Terrorists crashed passenger planes into the World Trade Center's Twin Towers in New York, into the Pentagon – the US Department of Defense headquarters in Arlington County, Virginia and into a field in Somerset County, Pennsylvania, 130 miles northwest of Washington, DC, the intended destination. Over 3,000 people were killed: 2753 in New York City, 184 at the Pentagon, and 40 on Flight 93 in Pennsylvania. Many more have died in the military and from related illnesses.



We remember and pray for those who lost their lives, those who grew up without a parent, those who lost a child, a sibling, a spouse, a friend, those who were present that day, the first responders who worked so hard and were sickened by the dangerous, toxic environment. We remember and pray for the members of the military that rose to the challenge to defend our country.

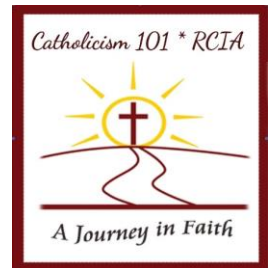

Beginning on Monday, September 13th, all adults have an opportunity to come and experience an educational program designed for you.

The program is called Catholicism 101, which we combine with RCIA, Rite of Catholic Initiation for Adults. Deacon Barney and Rory Kahn, both educators by trade, cover different topics each week, and will answer questions such as: Why are we, as Catholics, UNIQUE? What do we have that other Christians are missing? You may often leave the class saying, "I didn't know that!"



RCIA is for any adult thinking about catching up on missed Sacraments: Baptism, Penance, Communion, Confirmation. The sessions are completely interactive with slides and videos in a conversational format.
