Dear St. Columba Family,

There are a couple of exciting things that I would like to share with you this week. First, we have ordered some new vestments, green, red, purple, and rose. It is common for people to pay a donation and have a vestment memorialized in memory of a loved one. If anyone is interested in doing that, the cost is \$110 (which is the cost of each vestment) and the name of your loved one will be sewn into the back of the vestment. This will be done on a first come first serve basis. Please call the office if you are interested.

The second thing is that we are going to be looking for new Eucharistic ministers, lectors, and altar servers. If you are interested in serving please contact the office over the next two weeks and there will be a time scheduled for a practice before there is a formal induction as a new Eucharistic minister, lector or altar server.

Finally, you will notice in the next few weeks there will be two wooden hand rails installed in the sanctuary which will help any parishioners or priests when they are ascending the stairs to the altar. A generous anonymous donor has paid for it and we are grateful for their generosity.

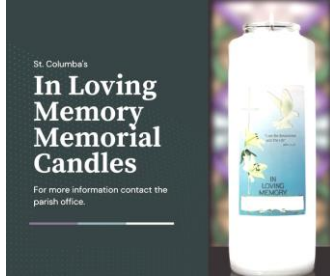
