CCD INFO

CCD REGISTRATION ... is scheduled for **Wednesday, August 22nd**, at **6:00 pm** in the parish hall. Students are not required to attend the registration. Baptismal certificates for all **new** students (including 1st graders) must be brought to the hall for registration. To obtain a certificate of Baptism, simply contact the parish church where the Baptism of your child took place. Then request that the baptismal certificate be sent to SJoA. If the Baptism took place at SJoA, simply contact the rectory and ask for the baptismal certificate of your child. Then pick up the certificate and bring it to the hall for registration. Baptismal certificates for *returning* students are not required. Finally, please know that there will **not** be any early registration for CCD this year.

4 YEAR HIGH SCHOOL CURRICULUM ... I mentioned last week that our CCD high school program now covers all four years of high school. TAKING A VACATION

I leave this evening for two weeks of vacation. Father Richard and I will be camping and fishing (and hopefully *catching* as well). I ask your prayers for safe travel. The following info will be helpful for my absence:

Father Vaughn will take the Masses on the weekend of July 28th & 29th. The following weekend (August 4th & 5th), **Msgr. Calkins** will take the anticipated Mass and Father Vaughn will take to the two Sunday Masses. There are no daily Masses scheduled during the next two weeks. (Daily Mass resumes Monday, August 6th.)

In my absence, Deacon Deshotel will attend to all emergencies. Should you need to speak with a Priest about something, simply call the rectory to be in touch with Deacon Deshotel. If it is after hours, his number is on the voicemail. If a Priest is required, Deacon Deshotel knows how to contact all the Priests in the surrounding area. They are prepared to assist as needed for emergencies.

Should a death occur and a Priest be needed, Deacon Deshotel is to be contacted first. All funeral calls and requests must go through Deacon Deshotel so that he can coordinate the details. His number is on the rectory voicemail. Father Vaughn will offer a funeral Mass should any arise in my absence.
