RCIA ... Instruction in the Holy Faith

Several people have expressed interest in either becoming Catholic or are presently Catholic but in need of instruction to prepare for sacraments such as Confirmation, Confession, Holy Communion, and Holy Matrimony. Do you fit in either of these categories? If so, contact Father Conner by phone at the Rectory. And don't be afraid to invite your family and friends to become Catholic or to pursue those sacraments missed in their earlier years.

Weekly Adoration for the “Catechism Year”

Beginning Thursday, September 5th, SJoA will have 4 hours of Eucharistic adoration each week. Adoration will begin at 3:00 pm and conclude at 7:00 pm. With the change of schedule for CCD, SJoA is shifting its weekly adoration from Wednesday to Thursday. The reasons for this change are twofold: first, the Church dedicates each Thursday to devotion to the sacred priesthood and the Most Holy Eucharist; second, having adoration on Thursday will allow adults who wish to attend Father's high school CCD class each Wednesday evening to participate in adoration the following afternoon/evening. A sign-up sheet is in the church. We need 3 adorers for each hour. The commitment to the weekly holy hour will run from September through December. In January, another sign-up sheet will be set out that runs through March.

IMPORTANT PARISH INFORMATION

MASS TIME CHANGE

Be reminded that, **beginning next Sunday, August 18th, the 10:00 am Mass will move to 10:30 am**. The reason for this change is to accommodate moving CCD Grades 1-8 to Sunday mornings.

NEW TIME FOR SUNDAY HOLY HOUR

Since the second Mass on Sunday morning will be 30 minutes later, we have enough time to insert an hour of Eucharistic adoration each Sunday between the early and late Masses. As such, beginning Sunday, August 18th SJoA will have an hour of adoration each Sunday, from 9:15 to 10:15 am.

CONFESSION TIME BEFORE THE 10:30 AM MASS

The time for confession before the second Sunday Mass will be adjusted to parallel the new Mass time. Confessions will be heard from 9:20 – 10:20 am each Sunday. Please note that confessions will continue to be heard before the early Sunday Mass, that is, from 6:30 – 7:20 am.

CCD INFO – GRADES 1-8

1. CCD Registration will be **Sunday, August 18th** ... beginning at **8:30 am**, that is, just after the 7:30 am Mass. There will be a brief period of registration after the 10:30 am Sunday Mass as well ... ***but you are encouraged to register before the 10:30 am Mass***. Registration fees are \$10 per child. No child will be turned away.
2. CCD classes begin for grades 1-8 on **Sunday, August 25th, 9:00 – 10:00 am**.

CCD INFO – GRADES 9-12

1. CCD Registration will be **Sunday, August 18th** ... beginning at **8:30 am**, that is, just after the 7:30 am Mass. There will be a brief period of registration after the 10:30 am Sunday Mass as well ... ***but you are encouraged to register before the 10:30 am Mass***. Adults may register by calling or coming by the rectory. Registration fees are \$10 per person.
2. **High School (grades 9-12) CCD remains on Wednesday, 6:00 – 7:30 pm.**
3. CCD classes begin for high school on **Wednesday, SEPTEMBER 4th**. *(Note this date has been updated.)*
4. **Parents: SJoA has a 4 year High School CCD curriculum. The youngsters are not sufficiently instructed simply because they have received the Sacrament of Confirmation. You, as a parent, should insist that your children attend CCD all 4 years of high school. Please get your son or daughter registered even if he or she has been confirmed.**

HOLY DAY OF OBLIGATION NOTICE

The Assumption of the Blessed Virgin Mary (Thursday, August 15th) **is a day of precept** (holy day of obligation). Deliberately missing Mass on a day of precept is a mortal sin (cf., CCC 2181). SJoA's Mass schedule for the Assumptions is: **6:30 am (OF), 12:05 OF, 6:00 pm (EF)**. Confession begins 30 minutes prior to each Mass.
