# Pilgrimage Response to Coronavirus Pandemic

**12 March 2020**

During this time of pandemic of COVID-19 — a respiratory disease caused by a coronavirus and impacting multiple countries worldwide — Bishop Glen John Provost is strongly urging parish or individual group pilgrimages in the Diocese of Lake Charles to the Shrine of Our Lady Star of the Sea in Cameron for the duration of the pandemic, and especially during this Lenten Season.

Every year Bishop Provost leads a pilgrimage to the Shrine at the beginning of the hurricane season. He said it is only appropriate that the faithful should seek Mary's intercession when so many are becoming ill and serious concern of the coronavirus is spreading.

"I fear that the faithful of the Diocese do not fully realize that Our Lady Star of the Sea is a duly erected shrine," said Bishop Provost. "We should seek Mary's intercession during this pandemic at this our own shrine, where her powerful intercession has come to our aid so often in the past."

The Shrine was established by Bishop Maurice Schexnayder in the 1960's, and Bishop Provost has recently approved a Decree establishing statutes for the Shrine. The Shrine enjoys, with papal approval, the same spiritual privileges as the Basilica of St. Mary Major in Rome, one of the four

major basilicas in the Eternal City. Under the usual conditions, a plenary indulgence may be gained.

The pilgrimage can be made either by individuals or parish groups and would include the following:

1) celebration of Holy Mass or some other Eucharistic devotion in the Church of Our Lady Star of the Sea (e.g. Holy Hour, Eucharistic Exposition, prayers before Our Lord present in the tabernacle)

2) procession from the parish church to the statue of Our Lady Star of the Sea (immediately adjacent to the church) while reciting or singing the Litany of Loreto (a copy of which is provided in the vestibule of the church for visitors)

3) concluding with the praying of an appropriate Marian prayer (e.g. the Memorare, the Hail Holy Queen) and/or the singing of a Marian hymn (e.g. *Stella Maris*, *Hail Holy Queen*, *Hail Queen of Heaven the Ocean Star*).

The Church of Our Lady Star of the Sea, located at 135 Our Lady Road, is open every day from 8 a.m. to 6 p.m. To make arrangements for Mass, other services, or for questions, contact Father D.B. Thompson, rector of the Shrine, at 337-542-4795.
