HISTORIC ORDINATIONS OF FOUR TO PRIESTHOOD JUNE 27

The highly anticipated ordinations of four men to the priesthood for the Diocese of Lake Charles will take place at 10 a.m. Saturday, June 27, in the Cathedral of the Immaculate Conception. The Most Reverend Glen John Provost, Bishop, will be the ordaining prelate with the Very Reverend Ruben J. Buller, Vicar General, serving as Master of Ceremonies.

During this 40th anniversary year of the Diocese of Lake Charles, the Sacrament of Holy Orders for Deacons Samuel Bond, Joseph Caraway, Andrew DeRouen and Levi Thompson will mark the largest group of men in the history of the Diocese to be ordained to the priesthood at one time. Michael Beverung will join the deacons in a step closer to the priesthood as he is ordained a transitional deacon.

Due to the historic number of ordinands and limited capacity, attendance will be by invitation only. The Mass will be streamed live for viewing on www.youtube.com/lcdioocese and www.facebook.com/lcdioocese.
