Decree for November 2020 Sunday Obligation

That the dispensation from the sacred obligation to attend Mass on Sundays and holy days of obligation is hereby lifted and, consequently, that the faithful of the diocese of Lake Charles are to return to this most sacred obligation, beginning on Sunday, November 29, 2020, the First Sunday of Advent.

Given on day 27 of November in the Year of Our Lord 2020.

- 1) That those who are ill, immune deficient, symptomatic, or in a state of anxiety over contracting illness are already dispensed in the law from the obligation to attend Mass;
- 2) That the directives of September 25, 2020, remain in effect with the sole exception of this return to the normal provisions for attending Mass on Sundays and Holy Days.
