Pastor's Corner

Here is the latest update on the Pastoral Planning Process of our Archdiocese. On April 18, representatives from each parish in Wallingford, Meriden, Southington, New Britain and Kensington (the new Deanery #5) will meet to discuss the proposal for the restructuring of our Archdiocese. Each parish is asked to send the two Lay Trustees, the Pastoral Council Chair, and a Finance Council member. Attending from St. Thomas will be Stan Maigarie (860-628-8350), Susan Howard (203-233-0003), John Kolosky (860-276-1239) and Jean Moriarty (860-628-4713).

Because of the large number of people attending, an open invitation is not practical. However, to ensure that everyone has a voice, please feel free to contact any of our representatives or me with any suggestions or comments you would like to raise, and we will bring them to that meeting.

It is important to keep in mind that the current pastoral model reflects many of the comments and opinions already voiced by priests and people of the Archdiocese. But, the current model needs to be reduced further, below the 115 pastorates (main church and any other church or ministry also run by that pastor) on the current plan, by an additional 10-15. This will ensure stability for the next 5-7 years based on the number of priests available. There are 156 pastorates today.

The latest timeline is for these Deanery meetings to take place in April, a final draft proposal to be drawn up in May by the Pastoral Planning Committee and be presented to the Archbishop, who will announce the Plan in June publicly. Then in July, the corresponding priest assignments will be announced, effective TBD.

Please continue to pray daily for the success of this difficult but extremely necessary process so that we might continue to grow as God's Church of Hartford.
