## VIDEO MONITOR AT THE CHAPEL

The Video Monitor at the Chapel was recently fixed. The presenting problem was with the camera. After our electricians searched for a replacement, we were informed that it is no longer in production. We contacted the company that initially installed the AV system for the Chapel and auditorium. Their advice was that the operating platform was outdated and needed to be upgraded. Rather than attempt a whole scale overhaul, it was decided to bypass the system and connect the new digital camera to the screen. The cost to do this was \$6,850. It will take, perhaps, the rest of the year to finance that through the monthly collection for restoration and maintenance. This month's collection total for the Chapel was \$686.

*"I am the good shepherd. The good shepherd lays down his life for the sheep."* How can we fail to see in these words an implicit reference to the mystery of the Lord's Death and Resurrection? *"I lay down my life that I may take it again. No one takes it from me, but I lay it down of my own accord, and I have power to take it up again"* (John 10:17–18). Christ freely offered himself on the Cross and rose by virtue of his own divine power. Therefore the allegory of the good shepherd has a strongly paschal character and for this reason the Church proposes it for our reflection during this Easter season. Christ's pastoral mission is a universal mission, which is not limited to the sons and daughters of Israel, but, by virtue of his sacrifice on the Cross, embraces all men and all peoples.

### CHURCH IN CENTRAL AND EASTERN EUROPE

As you know, every year we here in the Archdiocese of New York take up a special collection for the *Church in Central and Eastern Europe*. During the time of communist reign in many countries, practicing the faith became illegal, church buildings were confiscated, and people were forced to hide and secretly share the truths of the Gospel. After decades of institutional oppression and persecution, Catholics still struggle to rebuild not only their physical places of worship, but also their church ministries and communities. With your support of this collection, the Church is providing resources to these communities to breathe new life into the faith once again.

For example, the nation of Albania is nestled north of Greece in the Adriatic Sea. This small country suffered greatly under communist rule. In the capital of Tirana, located in the middle of the country, the Church is continuing to restore not only its structures, but also the spirituality of the faithful after years of oppression. In 1996, the congregation of sisters known as the Company of Mary Our Lady founded a kindergarten, the first Catholic school in the entire capital city. Since then, they have opened a school for grades 1–9 and a daily activity center for children. These sisters are now serving over 700 children daily from all different backgrounds, faiths, and ethnic groups. With your support of the *Church in Central and Eastern Europe*, these sisters will be able to make critical repairs to their building to continue their service. Your generosity

helps them to continue teaching children and equips the congregation to provide a space to build peaceful communities.
