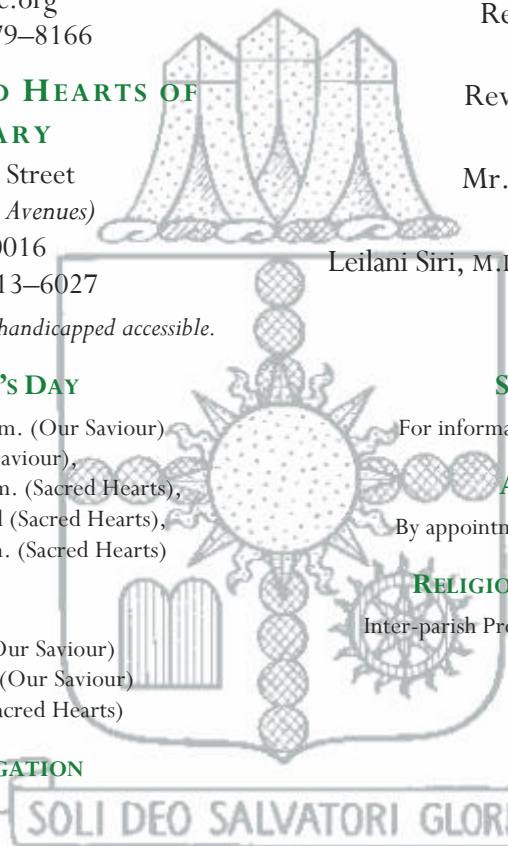

Friday, 2 November is the Commemoration of All the Faithful Departed, commonly known as the Feast of All Souls. In the narthex of the church, the lobby of the chapel, and in your monthly envelopes, you will find envelopes to be filled out enabling you to have your deceased loved ones remembered in a triduum of Masses for All Souls Day and throughout the month of November. Please be sure to return your enrollment envelope with the names of deceased family members, friends, neighbors, and co-workers to be remembered at Mass. They may be deposited in the collection basket, the offering boxes, or brought in advance to the Parish Office.

Please take this opportunity to visit the beautiful, peaceful cemeteries to remember those who have gone before us.

INDULGENCES DURING NOVEMBER

An indulgence, applicable only to the Souls in Purgatory, may be obtained by those who devoutly visit a cemetery and pray, even if only mentally, for the departed. The indulgence is plenary each day from the 1 to 8 of November. On all other days of the year it is partial.

A plenary indulgence, applicable only to the Souls in Purgatory, may be obtained by those who piously visit a church or public oratory on All Souls' Day, 2 November. On visiting the church or oratory it is required that one Our Father and the Creed be recited.

In order to receive these indulgences, you must be free from all attachment to sin, including venial sin, pray for the Holy Father's intentions (see the opposite page of the bulletin), reception of Holy Communion, and the Sacrament of Penance (Confession). Holy Communion and Penance must be received within seven days.
