RELIGIOUS EDUCATION REGISTRATION**Children grades 1 to HS:**

Registration and re-registration takes place from Tuesday to Friday 11am to 6:30pm in the rectory during regular office hours. Also, from 8am to 2pm on the following Sundays September 6 and 13.

One (1) child: \$70
Two (2) children: \$100
Three or more (3+) children: \$130

Baptismal certificates are necessary for children already baptized, otherwise a birth certificate.

Adults:

Those needing Baptism, Communion or Confirmation are prepared through the RCIA program. Registration takes place from Tuesday to Friday 11am to 6:30pm in the rectory during regular office hours.

We have had only a few requests for memorial bricks in the chapel garden. If we do not receive at least ten requests by September we plan to return any contributions already made. Meanwhile it is still possible to inscribe a paving brick in memory of a deceased loved one or in tribute to the living. The donation is \$200. Since we can install the bricks only if we have a minimum order of ten, we encourage anyone interested to register as soon as possible. There is always a long delay between submitting the order and the installation date and we would like to be able to do so early in the summer. Enrollment forms are available both in the rectory office.
