Confessions **will not** be held on the third Thursday of each month. You may say an "Act of Contrition" and go to Confession at your earliest convenience, or

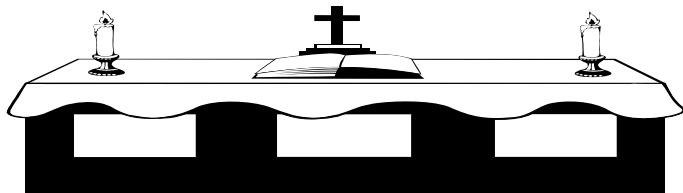
