

## 1st Reading – Isaiah 42:1-4, 6-7

Thus says the LORD: Here is my servant whom I uphold, my chosen one with whom I am pleased, upon whom I have put my spirit; he shall bring forth justice to the nations, not crying out, not shouting, not making his voice heard in the street. A bruised reed he shall not break, and a smoldering wick he shall not quench, until he establishes justice on the earth; the coastlands will wait for his teaching. I, the LORD, have called you for the victory of justice, I have grasped you by the hand; I formed you, and set you as a covenant of the people, a light for the nations, to open the eyes of the blind, to bring out prisoners from confinement, and from the dungeon, those who live in darkness.

**Responsorial Psalm – The Lord will bless his people with peace.**

## 2nd Reading – ACTS 10:34-38

Peter proceeded to speak to those gathered in the house of Cornelius, saying: "In truth, I see that God

shows no partiality. Rather, in every nation whoever fears him and acts uprightly is acceptable to him. You know the word that he sent to the Israelites as he proclaimed peace through Jesus Christ, who is Lord of all, what has happened all over Judea, beginning in Galilee after the baptism that John preached, how God anointed Jesus of Nazareth with the Holy Spirit and power. He went about doing good and healing all those oppressed by the devil, for God was with him."

## Gospel – Mark 1:7-11

This is what John the Baptist proclaimed: "One mightier than I is coming after me. I am not worthy to stoop and loosen the thongs of his sandals. I have baptized you with water; he will baptize you with the Holy Spirit." It happened in those days that Jesus came from Nazareth of Galilee and was baptized in the Jordan by John. On coming up out of the water he saw the heavens being torn open and the Spirit, like a dove, descending upon him. And a voice came from the heavens, "You are my beloved Son; with you I am well pleased."

**THE BAPTISM OF THE LORD**



Once again John the Baptist points us toward the One who comes in the power of the Holy Spirit. Once again we have an epiphany, a manifestation of who Jesus is. Three things happen in quick succession as Jesus comes out from the water: the heavens were torn open; the Spirit comes upon Him; and the Father speaks directly to Him, saying, "You are my beloved Son; with you I am well pleased." This is Jesus' own epiphany. The Father reveals Jesus to Himself as beloved Son. Following this, Jesus will be tested in the desert and then begin His ministry. Today we can reflect on our own Baptism when the Spirit first came upon us with the pouring of the water and the solemn pronouncing of the words: "I baptized you in the name of the Father, and of the Son, and of the Holy Spirit." On that occasion, the Father claimed us as God's beloved child. This year's Christmas season comes to an end, but we continue to live into the reality of our calling as a member of the Body of Christ.
