Parish Life Commission

Although there has been rain, but not heavy rain, since the last repairs were done on the bell tower, there has been no evidence of water in the bell tower. This will continued to be monitored. Cost responsibilities for the repairs are still being discussed. The church lighting work continues to be discussed by the contractors and engineers. Roger has painted some of the parking space lines. Fr. Weisenberger discussed creating a Building Committee. This would consist of approximately five people to organize a maintenance list/plan so that items may be maintained and budgeted. Please contact Fr. Weisenberger if you or someone you know is interested in being a part of this committee. The next Finance Council meeting is scheduled for November 12. As of the end of September, you have paid \$122,075 of your Fruitful Harvest pledges that totaled \$163,986 (parish goal set by the diocese is \$151,005.25). The Seminarian Fund goal for the parish is \$7,473. As of the end of September you have paid 6,204.
