Administration Commission

Sealant work on the bell tower continues. This work is taking a little longer than originally anticipated. Additional work is scheduled to be done at the end of October with all repairs and enhancements to be completed by mid to late November. A new phone system will be installed on October 13 in the parish offices. The kitchen freezer went out and new parts are no longer available. Therefore, a new freezer is needed. A thermometer has been placed in a drawer in the kitchen. Anyone working with food for a parish event should have their temperature taken. Livestream equipment will be installed October 15-16. To date, parishioners have pledged \$61,825 towards the parish goal of \$87,305 for the Catholic Ministries Appeal.
