### Administration Commission

The Bell Tower work continues. The sealant work has taken longer than expected. The exterior portion of the project should be completed by the end of November or first part of December. The livestream equipment has been installed and issues regarding the sound and camera color quality should be resolved by this weekend. The staff continues to practice using the equipment and others will be trained so livestreaming can begin. The Catholic Missions Appeal is going well. Currently \$85,740 has been pledged towards the parish goal of \$87,305.
