Suspension of the use of the chalice for distribution of Holy communion will occur until Easter; this will be reevaluated at that time. If you are sick or experiencing symptoms of sickness, you are not obligated to attend Mass, and even that out of charity you ought not to attend (c.f. CCC 2181). There will be a pump hand sanitizer for the Extraordinary Ministers of Holy Communion located near the ramp for use before and after Communion. There will also be a pump at the Credence table. Ushers will be informed of the location and the purpose of each AED (Automated External Defibrillator) in case of emergency use. The Feast of St. Joseph is Thursday, March 19 with Mass is at 6:00 pm. Lenten Penance Service is March 26 at 7:00 pm. Holy Thursday, Mass of the Lord's Supper is April 9 at 7:00 pm. Good Friday, Liturgy of the Lord's Passion is April 10 at 7:00 pm. The Easter Vigil will begin at 8:45 pm (sunset) on April 11 and Easter Sunday Masses will be at 8:00 am and 11:00 am. Sunday, April 19, the Divine Mercy Chaplet will be prayed at 3:00 pm.

Parish Life Commission

On Tuesday, February 25, Mardi Gras was celebrated with a pitch-in that was well received. Fifty-five people attended (15 more than last year). \$210 was collected as a free-will offering with expenses totaling \$630. The Knights of Columbus Fish Fry dinners will continue each Friday during Lent from 5:00 - 7:00 pm. On the first Friday, 390 adult and 17 children dinners were served with \$4,021.59 collected. On the second Friday, 509 adult and 21 children dinners were served with \$5,280.62 collected. Pictorial directories are being printed and should be shipped on March 30.

Chris Miller, St. Mary in Frankfort, asked for our help to start their own jail ministry. Blessings Bags for Spring will be assembled by the middle school EDGE group. Donation requests are in the bulletin. The goal is 100 bags. The Knight's councils in Carmel will be providing toys for kids during the food distributions. A diocesan Legion of Mary conference will be held in May. Threads of Compassion is gathering information about knitted and crocheted blankets for families of organ donors.
