## Parish Office Move at St. Mary

---

There was discussion regarding moving the parish offices to Gruber Hall very soon due to the lack of space for the staff in the current office space. There were no restrictions on the use of Gruber Hall from the Gruber family at the time the money was donated to the parish.

Eight office cubicles were found in Indianapolis for \$50 each. Fr. Paul, Fr. Dan and Shannon have seen the cubicles. They are used, but sturdy. Additional costs to do the move would possibly include additional electrical work, moving the phone system and some technology work (internet and computer networking).

## Fr. Dan to Study Spanish

---

Fr. Dan will be leaving for San Antonio, TX to study Spanish at the Mexican American Catholic College. He will be gone for the months of June and July. Fr. Paul has arranged for weekend Mass coverage while Fr. Dan is gone. During this time, there will not be daily Mass on Wednesdays at St. Mary and on Tuesdays, Thursdays, Fridays, and Saturday mornings at St. Joseph.

## Vaccination Clinic at St. Mary

The vaccination clinic that was scheduled to take place in the St. Mary parking lot on May 18-19 has been moved to another location due to complications with the tent set-up and traffic flow. Fr. Paul stated this clinic was approved by Bishop Doherty. He also discussed the cell-line issues of the various vaccines.
