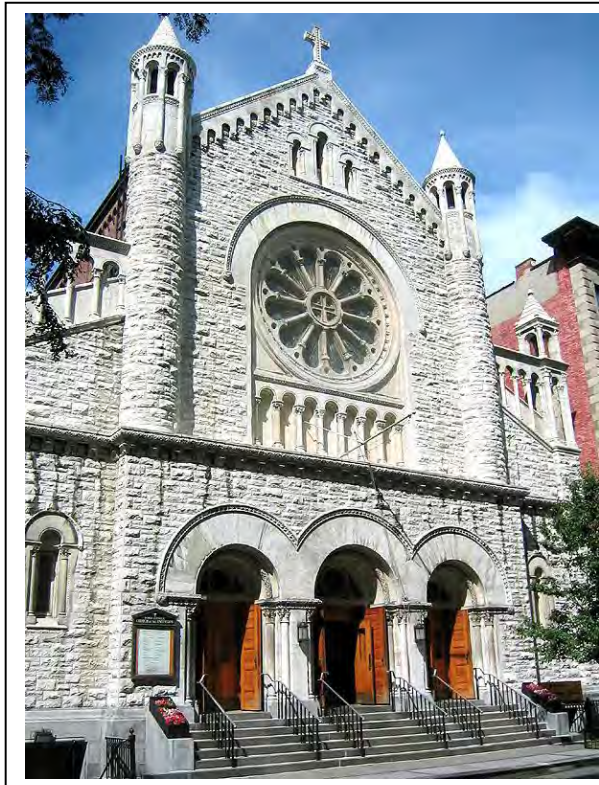

Dear Parishioners and Friends of Ascension,

When Jorge Bergoglio was elected pope, it became very clear to people that his ‘agenda’ would be a bit different from the agenda of his predecessors. Immediately upon becoming the Bishop of Rome, Pope Francis said, "How I would like a church that is poor and for the poor." Since making that statement,

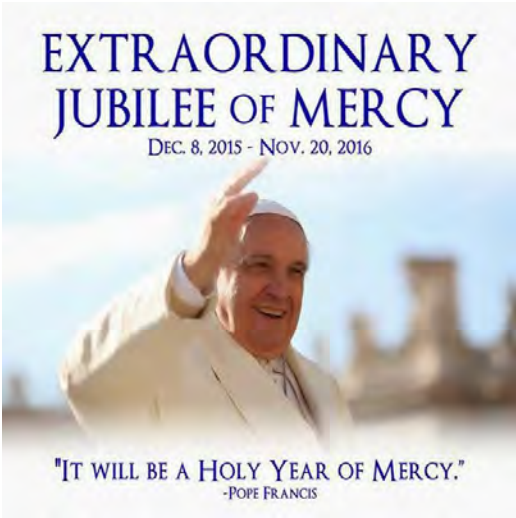
he has consistently positioned himself with the poor and has become one of their greatest advocates and ally. Similarly, Pope Francis, since the beginning of his papacy, has spoken consistently on the need for mercy. He speaks of the need for the church to be merciful to sinners, on how the church needs to be a witness to mercy, on the need for each of us to seek God’s mercy always, and on the gift of mercy itself and of how God is rich in mercy particularly towards those who turn to him with a sincere heart.

Since mercy has been such an important theme of Francis’ ministry, first as priest, then as bishop, and now as pope, Pope Francis, on March 13th, announced that there will be an extraordinary jubilee, A Holy Year of Mercy. This Holy Year will begin on December 8, 2015 (The Feast of the Immaculate Conception) and continue until November 20, 2016 (The Feast of Christ the King.) The purpose of this extraordinary Jubilee Year is to give everyone an opportunity to keep mercy in the forefront of our minds.

In this Holy Year, each of us is invited to open our hearts - most especially to those living on the outermost fringes of society. “During this Jubilee, the Church will be called upon even more to heal wounds, to assuage them with the oil of consolation, to bind them with mercy and cure them with solidarity and vigilant care.”

As a parish, we wish to be actively attentive to this Jubilee Year. In September, our Parish Council will have a discussion as to what we may do during this special year to make the message of mercy known. Queridos Feligreses y Amigos de la Ascensión,

Cuando Jorge Bergoglio fue elegido como papa, se le hizo muy evidente a la gente que su agenda sería un poco diferente a la de sus predecesores. Inmediatamente al convertirse en el Obispo de Roma, el Papa Francisco dijo, “Cómo me gustaría una iglesia que fuera pobre y para los pobres.” Desde que hizo esa declaración, se ha puesto consistentemente en el lugar de los pobres y se ha convertido en uno de sus mayores defensores y aliados. De la misma manera, el Papa Francisco, desde el principio de su papado, ha hablado consistentemente sobre la necesidad de la misericordia. Él habla acerca de la necesidad de que la iglesia tenga misericordia de los pecadores, cómo la iglesia necesita ser testigo de la misericordia, sobre la necesidad de que cada uno de nosotros busque siempre la misericordia de Dios y sobre el don de la misericordia en sí y cómo Dios es rico en misericordia en particular para aquellos que se acercan a él con un corazón sincero.

Como la misericordia ha sido un tema tan importante en el ministerio de Francisco, primero como sacerdote, después como obispo y ahora como papa, el Papa Francisco anunció el 13 de marzo que habrá un jubileo extraordinario – un año santo de misericordia. Este año santo comenzará el 8 de diciembre del 2015 (la fiesta de la Inmaculada Concepción) y continuará hasta el 20 de noviembre del 2015 (fiesta de Cristo Rey). El propósito de este extraordinario año de jubileo es para dar la oportunidad a todos de mantener la misericordia específicamente en nuestras mentes.

Durante este año santo, a cada uno se nos invita a abrir nuestros corazones – especialmente a aquellos viviendo en el extremo borde de la sociedad. “Durante el jubileo la iglesia estará más llamada aun a sanar heridas, a aliviarnos con el aceite de la consolación, para vendarlas con misericordia y sanarlas con solidaridad y cuidado vigilante.”

Como parroquia, queremos estar activamente atentos a este año de jubileo. En septiembre, nuestro Consejo Parroquial tendrá una discusión acerca de qué podemos hacer durante este año especial para hacer que se conozca el mensaje de la misericordia. 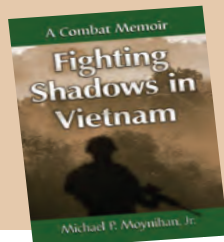
