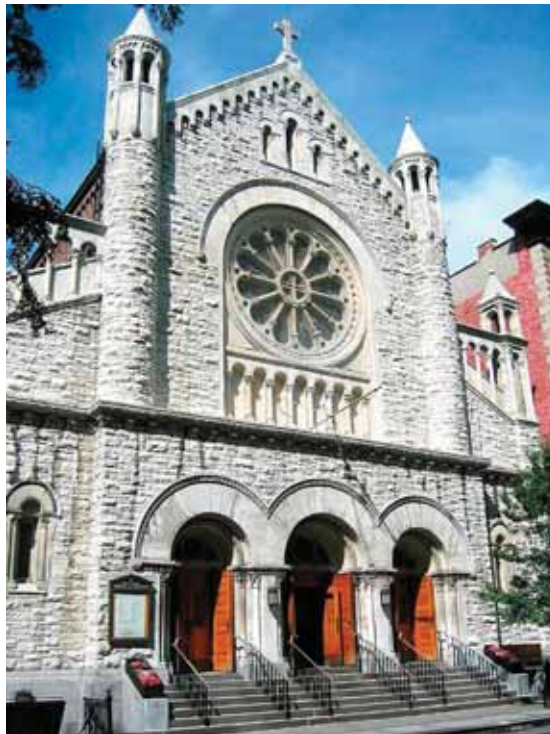

Pastor's Letter  
Notas del Pastor

Dear Parishioners and Friends of Ascension,

As many of you may have heard, Cardinal Dolan is hosting a series of “Regional Days of Mercy” throughout the Archdiocese for the Year of Mercy. These events, which begin at 2:30p.m., will include a talk from a missionary of mercy, a reflection from Cardinal Dolan, witness testimonies to the power of mercy, confessions, and

information about how to get involved in the corporal works of mercy. The Cardinal will celebrate the Vigil Mass and there will be a light reception to follow. The first such event will take place in Manhattan next Saturday, February 27th at the Church of Our Savior. Our Savior Church is located on Park Avenue and East 38th St. (59 Park Ave., New York, NY 10016.) All are invited to attend. In the spring, Ascension is planning a special parish pilgrimage to The Shrine of Mother Cabrini in Washington Heights. The Cabrini Shrine has been designated by Cardinal Dolan as a holy site and a place of pilgrimage, where a holy door, a door of mercy, will be opened and all those entering will receive a Jubilee indulgence.

A very important element of the Lenten Season is the final preparation of the Elect and the candidates as they prepare to receive the Easter Sacraments. For the next three weeks, the Elect will be present at the Sunday 6p.m. Mass for the scrutinies.

These very special rites are celebrated on the middle three Sundays of Lent. The Elect are those in our midst who are preparing for Baptism. Candidates are those who are already baptized but seeking the other Sacraments of Initiation. Part of their journey to the font is that they have been received among us through the Rite of Acceptance. These are ancient rites and they may, at first, seem strange to us. But they are profoundly rooted in our human experience. We need to examine (scrutinize) how we are, the areas of our lives where we are tempted, or seriously sin - in what we do and what we fail to do. We really need healing and the strength that can come from the support of our sisters and brothers. During these days of Lent, I ask that we all pray for the elect and the candidates in a profound way.

Queridos Feligreses y Amigos de la Ascensión,

Como muchos de ustedes habrán escuchado, el Cardenal Dolan estará auspiciando una serie regional sobre “Días de misericordia” a través de la arquidiócesis para el Año de la Misericordia. Estos eventos, que comienzan a las 2:30 de la tarde, incluirán una charla de un misionero de la misericordia, una reflexión del Cardenal Dolan, testimonios sobre el poder de la misericordia, confesiones e información acerca de cómo involucrarse en las obras corporales de la misericordia. El cardenal celebrará la misa de vigilia y seguido habrá una corta recepción. El primero de estos eventos tendrá lugar en Manhattan el próximo sábado, 27 de febrero, en la Iglesia de Nuestro Salvador (Church of Our Savior). La Iglesia de Nuestro Salvador está ubicada en la avenida Park y la calle 38 en la parte este (59 Park Avenue, Nueva York, 10016). Todos están invitados a asistir. En la primavera, la Ascensión está planeando un peregrinaje parroquial especial al Santuario de la Madre Cabrini en Washington Heights. El Santuario de Madre Cabirni ha sido designado por el Cardenal Dolan como un lugar sagrado y de peregrinación, donde una puerta, la puerta de la misericordia, estará abierta y todos aquellos entrando por ella recibirán una indulgencia del jubileo.

Un elemento muy importante de la temporada de Cuaresma es la preparación final de los elegidos y los candidatos a medida que se preparan para recibir los sacramentos pascuales. Durante las próximas tres semanas, los elegidos estarán presente en la misa de los domingos a las 6 de la noche para los escrutinios.

Estos ritos muy especiales serán celebrados en los tres domingos que marcan la mitad de la Cuaresma. Los elegidos son aquellos entre nosotros que se están preparando para el bautismo. Los candidatos son aquellos que han sido bautizados pero buscan los otros sacramentos de iniciación. Parte de su viaje a la fuente bautismal es que han sido recibidos entre nosotros a través del rito de aceptación. Estos son ritos antiguos y quizás al principio nos parezcan extraños. Pero están profundamente arraigados en nuestra experiencia humana. Necesitamos examinar (escudriñar) cómo somos, las áreas en nuestras vidas en que somos tentados, o pecamos seriamente – en lo que hacemos y en lo que dejamos de hacer. Verdaderamente necesitamos sanarnos y obtener la fuerza que puede venir del apoyo de nuestros hermanos y hermanas. Durante estos días de Cuaresma les pido que todos oremos por los elegidos y los candidatos de una manera especial.

### Encyclical on the Environment

Released on June 18, 2015, Pope Francis's encyclical, Laudato Si: On care for our Common Home Highlights several basic teachings. 

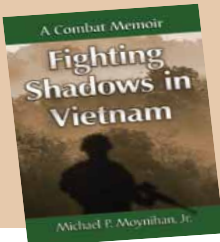
