Pastor's Letter
Notas del Pastor

Dear Parishioners and friends of Ascension,

Each year, during the month of September, we invite and encourage parishioners to consider being involved in some kind of parish ministry for the upcoming year. This weekend, there is a handout available in the back of the church with a list of many of the ministries that take place here at Ascension. (This list is not exhaustive.) We do

this in the month of September since most are back from vacation and many new people (including college students) are finding Ascension. We wish to give an opportunity to all those who wish to serve in some way. Last year we received a very positive response. We hope that will be the case again this year.

One of the reasons that being involved in parish ministry (volunteering) is so important is because it is a very beautiful way of giving back to God. Involvement in parish ministries is a way of thanking God for our blessings, jobs, and financial resources. We thank God not by simply sharing our treasure; we thank him by sharing our time and talent as well. We'd love to have you share your time and talent with our community. Although a representative from the Parish Council will be available after mass with these forms, please know that these forms are also available on our parish website as well. We would encourage those who are able to please fill out this form electronically.

Next weekend is the 19th Annual Marian Day Parade. The parade begins at 12 Noon on Amsterdam Ave., and 86th Street. The parade will go up Amsterdam and Mass will be celebrated here at Ascension at the conclusion of the parade. The Mass will be celebrated by Bishop Antonio Camilo, Bishop Emeritus of La Vega, Dominican Republic. All are invited to attend the parade and the Mass.

If you recall, in the late spring we asked for your generous support in order to do a necessary lighting project. The purpose of the project was to brighten up our church. For those that worship during the day, the poor lighting is not noticeable. When mass is celebrated in the evening or on dark days, the church is very dark and difficult for many who are trying to read and follow the parts of the mass from their worship aid (missalettes.) Whether people realize it or not, the darkest area, thus, the area from which it is most difficult to read, is the celebrant's chair and the altar. It took us a little longer than we had anticipated because we wanted to be sure that we had a company that would choose one of the more energy efficient types of lighting. We wish to be as "green" as possible. The project is well under way. No doubt you can already see a noticeable difference. We hope to be done with the project in the next week or so. I would like to thank those who responded so quickly and generously in making this project happen. Thank you all for your continued support and generosity to Ascension Church.

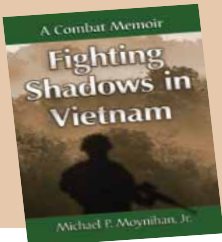
