Seton Catholic Fans,

This fall sports season presents some very unique challenges. One of the most difficult challenges is how to manage spectators at events. We recently met with a representative from the Wayne County Health Department and went over a plan to allow spectators at our home athletic events. The representative stressed that, due to contact tracing, we need to know where fans are sitting at each game. This was necessary to allow as many parents and family members see their children play as possible. Again, we know this isn't ideal, but we are doing this for the athletes and their families.

For volleyball events, we will be implementing the following plan:

- Per the Governor's mandate and the IHSAA's directive, masks will be required for all spectators.
- We will be limited to 80 Seton Catholic spectators
 - Spectators will sit in "family groups" of four people per group. We will socially distance as much as possible between each family group.
 - The number of spectators is based on the fact that we were able to create 20 family groups in the home sections of our bleachers.
 - **NOTE:** Each team member (player, manager, coach) will be allowed four spectators for the event. No other spectators will be allowed unless you are part of a team member's "family group."
 - Family groups are the seats that are NOT taped off with orange tape. Family groups will also be marked with a white circle on the front of the area or a colored number if someone is already sitting there.
 - Seton Catholic fans will sit in Sections 1 & 2.
- Beginning September 10, we will no longer be selling tickets at the door. Everyone must have a ticket prior to arrival or they will not be admitted. Team members will give tickets to distribute until our digital ticketing system is implemented.
 - Note: There will be a convenience fee charged to each ticket
 - We have not raised our ticket prices.
 - Beginning September 10, we will **NOT** be selling additional paper tickets at the door the night of the game. All tickets will either be distributed or be digital by means of this policy.

We will also be live-streaming our games live to our YouTube channel. We will be sure to communicate directions and/or links to access the games so those who cannot attend the game can still catch the action.

Again, we know some of these protocols are not ideal, but they are what is necessary to create a safe environment to allow our student-athletes to compete at this time. They also allow the student-athletes' parents and family members to watch them play. We sincerely appreciate your cooperation and we anxiously anticipate the day when we can return to normal.
