

Seton Catholic High School Dress Code

Revised August 2021

The uniform dress code of Seton Catholic High School is based on the belief that students should present an image that reflects a sense of pride in themselves, their families and their school. Students are expected to dress and carry themselves in a manner that upholds their dignity as a child of God. As long as a student is enrolled at Seton Catholic, he/she should represent and reflect the traditions of the school.

All students will observe dress regulations upon entering their classrooms, during the school day, and until after the dismissal at the end of the day.

Reasonable care and neatness in regard to properly fitting attire are expected of all students at school activities. Uniforms should be in good repair and kept clean. Uniform clothing cannot be written on or torn.

Vendors of school uniform polo shirts, blue pullovers, hoodies and crewneck sweatshirts include Circle E Printing and BSN. Contact the school office for the name and number of our school embroiderer.

WAIST DOWN

Bottoms:

MALES: Pants, Shorts

FEMALES: Pants, Shorts, Skirts, Skorts, Jumpers or Capris

- Navy Blue or Khaki ONLY
- NO holes or tears
- NO leggings, jeggings, joggers, or jeans
- Nothing shorter than 4" above the knee
- Shorts and Capris: Aug-Nov 1 and April 1-June ONLY

Belts:

- Must be worn at all times
- Any color/design belt must be worn with pants/shorts
- Must have belt loops on pants/shorts

Socks & Tights:

- Any color/design socks or SOLID color tights must be worn at all times
- Solid color tights must be worn with skirts, skorts and jumpers Nov 1- April 1

Shoes:

- Must have back strap and cover toes
- No clogs, flip-flops, Crocs, skate shoes or open toe shoes

WAIST UP

Tops:

- Grades 7 & 8: red polo shirts with school logo
- Grades 9-11: navy blue polo shirts with school logo
- Grade 12: black polo shirts (2020-2021 only)
- Uniform shirts must be tucked in at all times
- Long sleeve shirts CANNOT be worn under short sleeve polo shirts

Cold Weather Tops:

- Navy blue pullovers and crewneck sweatshirts with a Seton Catholic logo
- Must be worn over uniform shirt
- Coats and jackets are not permitted in the classroom (including Seton Catholic letter jackets)
- Beginning Jan. 1, 2022: no hoodie sweatshirts can be worn.
- CHWC and NCYC logos are not permitted as part of the school uniform

Earrings, Accessories, & Tattoos:

- No pierced body jewelry, other than pierced ears for girls
- No chains and other accessories hanging from clothing/body
- No visible tattoos
- Fingernails—painting permitted for females (no dark colors); not appropriate for males.

Hair & Hair Color:

- Hair must be neatly cut and clean
- Hair must be a natural color
- Boys' hair must not hang over the collar and must be trimmed above the eyebrows
- Boys must not have facial hair
 - Boys in the senior class may have facial hair, but it must be neatly groomed

Special School Day Dress Codes

Seton Spirit Wear Days:

Occurs on 2nd, 3rd, 4th and 5th Fridays of the month

- Uniform bottoms, blue jeans, Seton sweatpants, and khaki or navy blue shorts (when in season) are acceptable
- Wear ANY Seton top – jersey, t-shirt, vest, sweatshirt, hoodie
- In colder months, a Seton t-shirt may be worn over a long sleeved shirt or turtleneck
- **NO** leggings, jeggings, or cut off shorts
- **NO** holes or tears are permitted

**Free Dress Days:
Occurs on 1st Friday of the month**

- Blue jeans, sweatpants, and shorts (when in season) are acceptable
- **NO** holes or tears are permitted
- Shirts must have sleeves, shoulders must be covered
- Same shoe, jewelry and hair rules apply

Violation Procedure

Dress code violations will be dealt with in one or more of the following manners:

- Warning
- Detention
- Exclusion from classes until proper clothing is obtained (permission by parent or guardian necessary if student needs to leave school premises to obtain it)
- Suspension

NOTE: Final determination as to the appropriateness of dress, personal appearance, hair length, and hairstyle or hair color will be made by the Principal or Dean of Students.
