## **COVID 19 Update**

**September 27, 2021**

Dear Parents/Guardians,

### **High School:**

Although the Governor's quarantine mandate ends on September 30, 2021 (Thursday), Seton Catholic High School has one positive Covid case requiring masking for all staff and students for an additional 14 days. Therefore, Seton Catholic High School will remain masked through October 7<sup>th</sup>.

### **Elementary:**

On October 1, 2021, Seton Catholic Elementary School is reporting zero cases and will return to mask optional. Below are key points about masking versus non-masking.

- Seton Catholic Schools HIGHLY recommend all staff and students continue to wear masks during the school day and sporting events.
- Students who do not wear masks will be required to quarantine should they be exposed to a positive COVID.
- Students who are masked, will be notified of close contact, but will not be required to quarantine.

### **All Campuses:**

As a precaution, all campuses will return from Fall Break MASKED until October 30<sup>th</sup>. This is to ensure there are no active cases that developed during Fall Break. Many parents/students are planning vacations, and we feel it is important to have an enhanced layer of protection upon returning to school on October 18<sup>th</sup>.

Our excellent cleaning protocols will continue to ensure staff and students are in a sanitized learning and working environment. Should we be required by the state to change the above information, we will send out notifications to parents and guardians.

***We have used a large amount of our mask inventory for the year! Please provide your child with a clean mask daily. We will not be providing paper masks unless there is an emergency during the day. Parents will be called to bring masks should students not have one available to them. For your convenience, we gave each student in the high school a washable cloth mask today.***
