2021-2022 Tuition & Fees for 9-month School Year

Children's House Level: 3 to 6 years old (must be fully toilet trained)

Full Day Tuition: \$499/month over 12 months or \$5988 annually

Half Day Tuition: \$315/month over 12 months or \$3780 annually

Kindergarten Tuition: \$315/month over 12 months or \$3780 annually

(be sure to review the notes for Children's House at the end of this document)

Lower Elementary Level: 6 to 9 years old (grades 1-3)

Tuition: \$315/month over 12 months or \$3780 annually

*Children who are 9 before August 1, 2021 will register for Upper Elementary

Upper Elementary Level: 9 to 12 years old (grades 4-6)

Tuition: \$315/month over 12 months or \$3780 annually

*Children who are 12 before August 1, 2021, will register for the Adolescent Program

Additional Programs

Saint Joseph's Little Workers (Before & After School Programs)

All registered students in Saint Joseph Catholic Montessori School are welcome to register for before & after school care. Students enrolled in Before & After School Care will participate in a variety of activities to include Montessori lessons, outdoor play, St. Joseph's workshop, gardening, open gym, science & sensory activities, and art. Students who arrive before 7:55 am will have the opportunity to attend daily mass with staff.

Before Care Hours: 7:30 am-School opens

Monthly fee: \$84/month

After Care Hours: School dismissal-5:30 pm

Monthly fee: \$166/month

Camp Saint Joseph (Summer Montessori Program)

All registered 2021-2022 St. Joseph's students are welcome to register for Camp Saint Joseph. Students enrolled in Camp Saint Joseph will receive Montessori education in the areas of Practical Life, Sensorial, Math, Language, Cosmic (Science, History, Geography, Culture), Art, Gardening, Gym, and St. Joseph's Workshop. Students who arrive before 7:55 am will have the opportunity to attend daily mass with staff on Thursdays.

Program dates: June 1, 2021 – August 20, 2021 (closed on Monday, July 5th)

Full Day hours: 7:30 am – 5:30 pm

Half day mornings: 7:30 am – 12:30 pm

Half Day afternoons: 12:30 pm – 5:30 pm

Pre-K Children's House Full Day Tuition: \$2,340 or 3 payments of \$780

Pre-K Children's House Half Day Tuition: \$1,470 or 3 payments of \$490

K – 6th Grade Full Day Tuition: \$2,040 or 3 payments of \$680

K – 6th Grade Half Day Tuition: \$1,290 or 3 payments of \$430

Additional Information

Multiple Child Discount: We offer a multiple child discount of \$300 for each additional child after the first child. For example: \$300 off total annual family tuition for the 2nd child; \$600 off the total annual family tuition for the 3rd child.

Registration fee (for all levels): \$175. This is non-refundable and must be paid at registration to hold your child's spot for the 2021-2022 school year.

Supply Fee (for all levels): \$75. This is non-refundable and must be paid by the beginning of the school year. The supply fee covers classroom supplies that your child will use throughout the academic year.

Lunches: will be paid separately

ⁱ NOTES FOR CHILDREN'S HOUSE

- I. **Age of Entry:** To be accepted into Children's House, children must turn 3 before August 1, 2021 and be fully toilet trained. Any exceptions to age cut-off date will be made on an individual basis.
- II. **Kindergarten age:** Children who turn 5 before August 1, 2021 are considered "Kindergarten" and will register for Full Day Children's House at the "Elementary" rate of \$3780.
- III. **Lower Elementary age:** Children who turn 6 before August 1, 2021, will sign up for Lower Elementary only if they have previously completed 1 yr of Kindergarten in either Children's House or School. Parents may keep a 6 yr old child in Children's House if it is determined that the child would benefit from another year in Children's House before moving on to Lower Elementary.

IV. Toilet training policy

- a. Children enrolled at Saint Joseph Catholic Montessori School must be fully toilet trained. A fully toilet trained child can do the following:
 - i. Communicate to the Guides the need to use the restroom.
 - ii. Stop what he/she is doing to go and use the restroom.
 - iii. Undress and dress without assistance.
 - iv. Wipe him/herself after using the toilet.
 - v. Get on/off the toilet by him/herself.
 - vi. Wash and dry hands.
 - vii. Postpone use of toilet if the restroom is in use or if away from the restroom.
 - viii. Awaken during rest time should they need to use the restroom.
 - ix. Students in the Children's House must have an extra set of clothing left at school, including underwear and socks, in case of an accident. We do understand that young children will occasionally have toileting accidents. By definition, "accidents" are unusual incidents and should happen infrequently. In these instances, the children will need to have the ability to independently and successfully change their clothes and clean themselves. Parents will be notified if a child has a toileting accident. Persistent instances may conclude in suspension or expulsion.
 - x. If three or more accidents occur in one week, the parent will be notified with the understanding that if the issue isn't corrected by the end of the second week, the child will have to stay home at least one week until he/she is fully toilet trained. Tuition will not be pro-rated during this time. Parents should contact the principal to facilitate the child's return to school.
 - xi. If multiple accidents occur in one day, the parents will be notified and will need to bring a change of clothes and/or pick up the child; if not corrected after three days, the child will need to stay home at least one week until he/she is fully toilet trained. Tuition will not be pro-rated during this time. Parents should contact the principal to facilitate the child's return to school.
