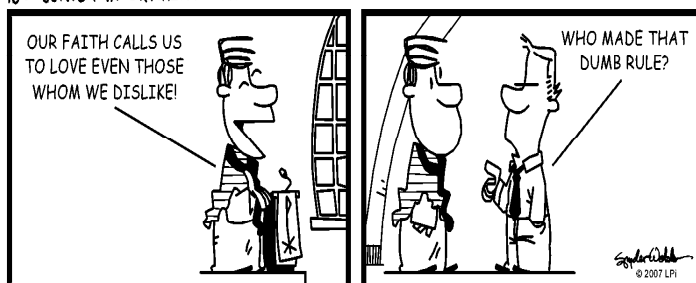

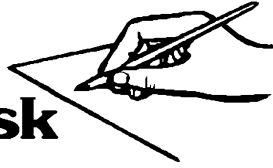

From the Pastor's Desk



People often speak with me about their grown children who do not practice their faith. I have given advice, offered prayers, and encouraged people to talk with the many other parents who have experienced the same thing. Recently I was surprised to hear about a new resource that addresses this. "Return: How to draw your child back to the Church." There is a book by Brandon Vogt by this name which is available for free at www.freereturnbook.com. I have not read it, but it has received great reviews. It also links to a video course and interviews that are on line. The three sets of material are meant to reinforce each other and offer advice on various approaches that we can take when inviting people back to the Church. I do hope to read it at some point, so if you order it I would like to hear your thoughts and possibly borrow your copy. If there are several people who decide to check it out, you may want to meet at some point to share your thoughts, concerns, and attempts in this regard.

On another topic. I wrote last week about my upcoming training. It looks like we will have a religious order priest from the Society of African Missions who will be in residence here during my time away. This will mean that we can have both weekend and weekday Masses. We will have a priest available for funerals and anointings. And, we should be able to have mid-week confessions at St Mary. We will need to work out the details of who can drive him to services, but I am thrilled that we will have complete coverage for when I am away. As I mentioned, all my future trainings will be much shorter, so coverage should be easier in future years.
