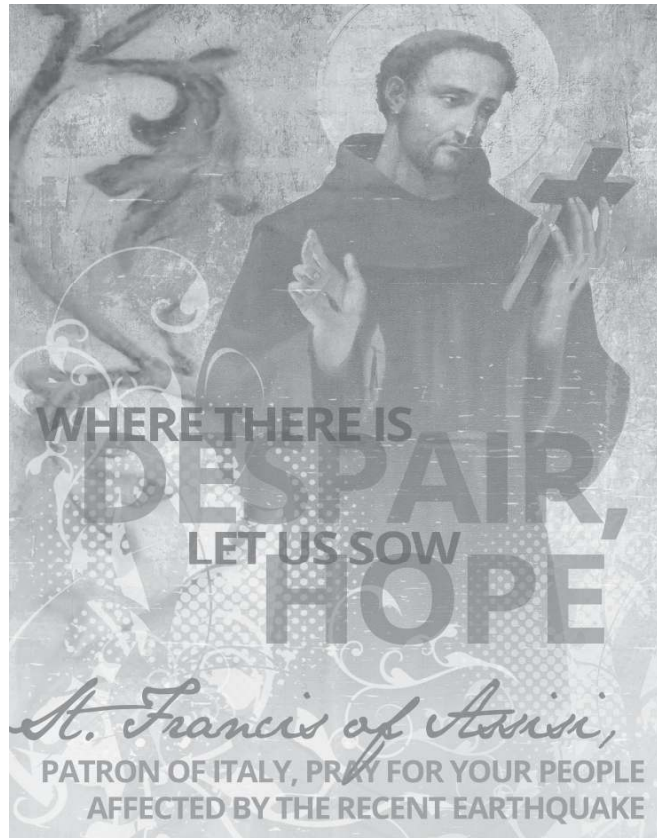

PASTOR'S NOTES:

It has been a couple very interesting weeks since I have written. The Chaplain Course is a series of presentations punctuated with practical assignments and experiential learning. One very powerful one is the visit to the cadaver lab at the local medical school. I am writing this just after returning from the lab. Medical students showed us the bodies which have been donated to science and the work they are doing on them. We were asked to handle some of the internal organs, and shown important locations within the body where one might have to do an intervention to stop bleeding or open an airway. It was fascinating, and was done with such respect for the people who donated their bodies so that the next generation of doctors-and chaplains- can learn.

This past week we have also been learning counseling techniques, how to work with our enlisted team members on projects, and important things to know about staying in the Air Force and helping ourselves and others in our offices to achieve promotions and other recognitions. We traveled to Joint Base Charleston to learn about how different branches of the military work together on joint bases, and how sometimes working together can be a challenge. We also learned about how chaplains work as part of a team to respond to traumatic events. Since it does get a bit overwhelming at times, we also continue to socialize and exercise together (My team won several dodge ball games!)

Luckily there is time on the weekends which we can use for things like my visit to my brother and his wife who live only a couple hours from Fort Jackson. Also very lucky for me that mail has started arriving. It seems there is about a five day delay once mail reaches the post, but I received several letters and cards today and a care package. I want to thank everyone who has written, and everyone who has been keeping me in prayer. I also want to let you know that I have been praying for y'all, most especially during my early morning runs and morning prayer. I look forward to seeing you all again soon.
