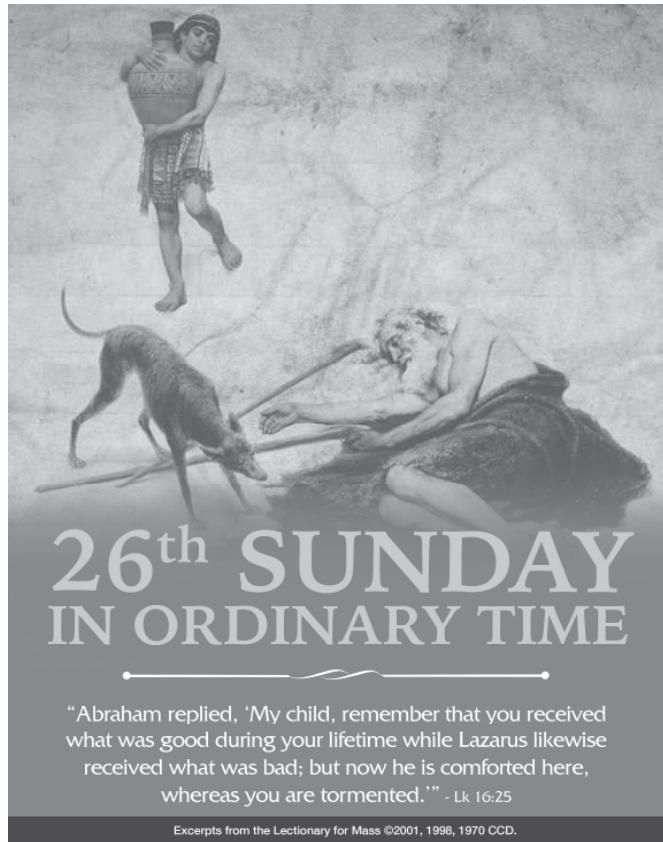

From the Pastor's Desk



It has been a couple of weeks since I wrote about my chaplain training, and even though now I am back I want to share with you some last thoughts and let you know where that puts me in terms of service.

I had mentioned before about our visit to the gross anatomy lab, where we handled the bodies and organs of those who donated their bodies for the training of doctors and other medical staff. The course also included things like an inspection of our dress uniforms, and practice doing services at the local veterans cemetery. We studied protocol, and death notifications, and how to properly brief a commander, and how to work with married couples to strengthen their relationships. A particularly sobering time was when we watched a documentary about events at the military hospital in Baghdad. In this movie there were plenty of gory scenes, and we saw the chaplain moving in and out of various situations. Like so many parts of the chaplain course it is designed to prepare us-in particular to prepare us for deployment.

My class was a mix of Guard, Reserve, and Active Duty chaplains. All of us now become eligible for deployment, though deployments are on different time lines for the different groups. One of my classmates will be leaving in a month or so for her first deployment, while my base at Pease has already submitted the names of those who will deploy next year and is not scheduled to be tasked again for five years in the normal rotation. So, for me, anything can happen, but I am not expecting to deploy for a few years. In that time I have more training to take care of-though thankfully none of it as long as what I have already done.

As I mentioned a few times...it is really good to be home. Thanks again for all your support and prayers, and for your patience as I get my mind and heart back here too.
