As of June 1st we will be ONLY collecting WINTER CLOTHES, HAT, GLOVES, MITTENS, SCARFS, BOOTS, SOCKS AND PERSONAL CARE ITEMS (TOOTHPASTE, DEODORANT, ETC). No bedding items, no spring, summer or fall clothing, no shoes etc. The people continuing to support the homeless have limited space so that's why they are only collecting winter items. Please save your winter items for the homeless. As you know, last winter was a long one and these folks don't have washers and dryers so they need to replace their winter items often. Keep in mind that clothing the naked is one of the corporal works of mercy. Thanks for your help.

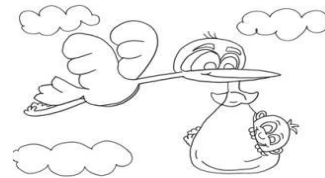

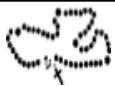
ANNUAL BABY SHOWER



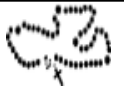
Once again, St. Mary's Outreach will be conducting our annual baby shower for local mothers in need, from May 21st through June 18th.
