### Criteria for Applicants:

1. Assistance is for motivated students displaying evidence of both financial need and strong moral character.
2. Applicants must be full-time students, entering either an accredited four-year college/community college or technical school, and be enrolled for a minimum of 12 credit hours.
3. Applicants can be of any faith but must reside in Seminole or Volusia Counties or be attending Bishop Moore or Father Lopez High Schools.
4. Applicants must have a minimum of a 2.5 GPA.
5. Applicants **MUST** complete and verify FAFSA, (i.e., a Pell Grant) and apply for other scholarships or loans.
6. Applications must be post marked or electronically submitted by March 29, 2021. If requested, applicants must be available in the evening for a virtual interview during the week of April 12-16, 2021.
7. The scholarship money will be deposited in a student's account at his/her school of choice.

Recipients **should plan to attend** a socially distanced SVDP Scholarship Awards Ceremony at 7 PM on Monday, May 19, 2021, in Sanford, Florida.
