<b>ABORTION LIMITS:</b> Prohibiting abortion when a fetus has reached 20 weeks gestation and has the capacity to feel pain?	<b>SUPPORT</b>
<b>ACCESS TO HEALTH CARE:</b> Increasing health coverage options for uninsured Floridians, especially the unemployed and the working poor?	<b>SUPPORT</b>
<b>AFFORDABLE HOUSING:</b> Using all state housing trust funds as intended to address affordable housing needs in Florida?	<b>SUPPORT</b>
<b>CRIMINAL JUSTICE:</b> Authorizing courts to impose a sentence less than the mandatory minimum term of imprisonment for nonviolent crimes? <i>Optional Comments: I support this, however, it should be practiced on an individual basis. Some non-violent criminals should have to serve a mandatory minimum, but this should depend on the severity of the crime.</i>	<b>SUPPORT</b>
<b>DEATH PENALTY REPEAL:</b> Ending Florida's use of the death penalty while preserving the alternative of a life sentence without parole? <i>Optional Comments: I support the death penalty only in the most egregious and solidly proven guilty crimes.</i>	<b>SUPPORT</b>
<b>END-OF-LIFE PROTECTION:</b> Preserving Florida law that bans doctor-prescribed suicide?	<b>SUPPORT</b>
<b>FREEDOM TO SERVE:</b> Allowing health care providers and workers the freedom to serve in accord with their conscience?	<b>SUPPORT</b>
<b>PARENTAL EMPOWERMENT:</b> Eliminating the requirement to attend public school the year prior to receiving a state scholarship for K-12 non-public schools? <i>Optional Comments: Parents should have the ability to choose where their child is educated. Families that move into areas of underperforming public schools should not be penalized.</i>	<b>SUPPORT</b>
<b>PROTECTING WORKERS:</b> Requiring drinking water, shade, and annual heat illness training be provided for farmworkers and other outdoor workers?	<b>SUPPORT</b>
