Frequently Asked Question

**Q:** How did the Archdiocese decide what amount to ask my family?

**A:** Ask amounts were set by looking at a number of factors, including: a parish offertory snapshot, parishioners giving history to the Annual Catholic Appeal, other archdiocesan giving history (golf tournament, Crozier Society, etc.), planning study responses, other public knowledge of philanthropic giving, and capacity and an evaluation done by the parish.

The archdiocese has no way of knowing what a family's personal financial situation, income or obligations are. Capital campaigns are about extraordinary giving towards extraordinary goals. To accomplish these goals, every parish family must be challenged to consider a gift above and beyond their regular support to their parish and the Appeal.

**The amount of their gift or pledge is their personal decision.**

**Sound System Update**



One of the designated projects for the rebate from last year’s Annual Catholic Appeal was to update our current sound system. This project was completed last week and included some new microphones, monitors, and a sound board with a remote control that can be used to adjust the sound within the church and eliminate feedback. The hearing assist system has been repaired and there are several devices in the sacristy for those who would like to use them during Mass. Please be patient as we fine tune the sound levels in the coming weeks and consider that what is soft to one person may be loud for another. Also, in working with the system, we have realized that the sound at the back of the church is always going to be louder because of the way the pews and ceiling tiles are arranged. We will work hard to find the best balance that we can.
