

*Please fill out a registration card if you have never filled one out, your marital status changes or your children are now adults and no longer living with you. (If your children are now adults, no longer living with you and attend Mass, they need to fill out their own registration card.)

* Please advise the office if you have a change of address, phone number, email, birth of a child, death, or change of parish (you can be registered at one parish only).

Updating your information allows us to insure you receive correspondence and phone calls in a timely manner, mail is discontinued if you are no longer with the parish and the correct information is on letters when one spouse is deceased and/or families do not receive forwarded mail after their loved one is deceased. Additionally, filling out a registration card or updating your information allows for us to process baptism, first communion, and confirmation paperwork quickly. Lastly, on occasion, we have received requests for a return phone call or something to be mailed and the information we are given is incorrect. When we have tried to look the individual up in our computer system to return a phone call or re-mail the requested information, the individual is not registered or the information in the computer is incorrect.
