Is there a family you know who needs assistance? Please call the Society of St. Vincent de Paul so that together we can help the suffering and poor.

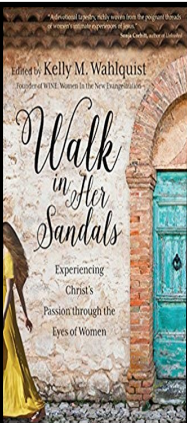
Have you ever considered answering the call "to bring glad tidings to the poor" by joining the Society of St. Vincent de Paul? We meet every other Tuesday at 7pm.
