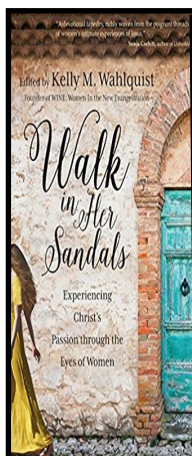

1. As a rule, always check the sender's email address and subject line. Fr. Marc will never send you an email randomly asking you to assist someone financially, request gift cards or iTunes or other forms of cards that can be monetized.
2. Never click on any attachment from people you are not familiar with.
